13. **Rioja Vega Blanco** – Rioja, Spain 25.00
The nose has aromas of conference pear, white flowers and some limey notes. Fresh, clean and crisp in the mouth with good length and balance. perfectly balanced on the palate.
33. **Tempranillo Blanco, Rioja Vega** - Rioja, Spain 32.00
Unctuous and sweet attack on the mouth which develops into fresh citrus flavours. A subtle silky texture from the ageing on its fine lees in French oak barrels.
39. **Tempranillo Blanco Reserva 2018, Rioja Vega** -Rioja, Spain 69.00
Rich, intense and complex bouquet full of nuances. Aromas of tea and honey, with subtle smokiness. Hints of oak from barrel ageing.

ROSE

41. **Tempranillo Rosado, Rioja Vega** - Rioja, Spain 32.00
A delicate wine with hints of white flowers on the nose. Expressively fresh on the palate, with a good acidity.

RED

57. **Rioja Vega Tempranillo** - Rioja, Spain 25.00
Bright ruby red, dark and elegant - the nose is forward, developed and mildly jammy, offering notes of boiled red and black fruits, spice and leather.
59. **Rioja Vega Crianza** - Rioja, Spain 29.00
A bright, fruit driven Rioja with notes of cherry and cassis and a soft vanilla edge from the oak. Smooth, soft and fruit driven.
75. **Rioja Vega Reserva** - Rioja Spain 39.00
The nose has aromas of freshly picked berry fruits with a lovely hint of sweet vanilla. The palate is more intense in flavour with plum, blackcurrant leaf and tobacco aromas.
73. **Rioja Vega Gran Reserva 2015** - Rioja, Spain 48.00
Ruby red colour of medium intensity, clean and bright. Delicate and elegant balsamic aromas with well-integrated toasted hints. Soft and fine on the palate, with well balanced structure and a velvety texture.
68. **Rioja Vega Venta Jalon Reserva 2014** - Rioja Spain 68.00
Rich and complex bouquet revealing terroir-driven balsamic and spicy varietal character. Full bodied, with a subtle underlying mineral character on the palate.

- 1. Prosecco "Il Fresco" - Villa Sandi, Italy** 27.00
One of the great estates in Prosecco. A delightful, fresh, fruity sparkling wine.
- 2. Gardet Brut Tradition - Chigny-les-Roses** 48.00
Altogether fresh, with a full-bodied consistency, fine acidity and a balance between creamy and bold.
- 3. Laurent Perrier Brut** 70.00
45% Chardonnay, 40% Pinot Noir and 15% Pinot Meunier. Delicate with hints of citrus fruit and great balance.
- 4. Bollinger Special Cuvee** 85.00
Bollinger is made from first-run juice only, and the majority of vineyards used have Premier and Grand Cru status, resulting in a full-bodied Champagne of great class.
- 5. Pol Roger Brut Réserve NV** 80.00
Rich nose, deep and opulent - there is cream, tropical fruit, brioche and toasty vanilla notes - great elegance and a fine finish.

On the nose, there are floral aromas together with citrus notes of lemon and orange peel. A complex and delicate palate of berries, redcurrants, blackcurrants, blackberries, jam and stewed fruits all combine to create a beautifully graceful, harmonious and silk textured Champagne.

| Very full and intensely fruity on the nose with exotic fruit such as melon and banana, featuring hints of citrus reminiscent of grapefruit. | |

| No oak used here, just pure, fresh varietal Chardonnay flavours. Bags of ripe fruit with good acidity. This wine is quite outstanding! | |
| 17. Pinot Grigio - Ca' Tesore, Veneto, Italy | 23.00 |
| A fresh and fruity wine, with a bouquet of tropical and citrus fruit, elegant and perfectly balanced on the palate. | |
| 18. Ile de Beaute Blanc - Domaine Barcelo - Corsica, France | 29.00 |
| A fine, expressive, complex nose, with aromas of citrus and white flowers. The palate is at first fresh and sumptuous, ending with a pleasant fruity acidity. | |

CRISP DRY AROMATIC WINES

Predominantly Sauvignon based wines but will also cover Riesling and steely Chardonnay such as Chablis. Again no oak ageing. These wines are totally dry (i.e. no residual sugar) and make great aperitifs or perfect with fish.

| Jean Pabiot makes a great Pouilly Fume, bags of ripe, grassy asparagus fruit with a delicious gun flint overtone. | |
| 27. Sancerre 'Le Pierrier' - Domaine Jean Thomas, Loire, France | 41.00 |
| Classic Sancerre, crisp, fresh and full of mouthwatering opulent gooseberry fruit flavours. Beautifully restrained with all the subtle nuances that the region originally became famous for. | |
| 28. Chablis 1er Cru 'Montmains' 2017 - Domaine de Marronnieres, France | 45.00 |
| One of the finest 1er Crus offering unrivalled elegance, yet with the tightly knit structure that ensures excellent ageing potential - great vintage. | |
| 29. Sauvignon Blanc - Kuki, Marlborough, New Zealand | 31.00 |
| Lifted notes of fresh grapefruit and tropical fruits on the nose leading to a fresh palate with concentrated fruit flavours and a mouth-watering finish. | |
| 30. Sauvignon Blanc 2021 - Cloudy Bay, New Zealand | 45.00 |
| Bright, focused citrus aromatics of grapefruit and kaffir lime abound, supported by subtle tropical notes. | |

FULL BODIED WHITE WINE

This section is predominantly oak aged Chardonnays. The oak gives the wine greater depth of flavour and richness. These are definitely food wines and can accompany light meats, such as chicken or veal. With lobster look no further than the Meursault from Michelot - Bin 34.

| A wine of great purity, intense and tightly bound with notes of stone and mineral. The acidity is very good and will enable it to age well. | |

| This wine takes its name from Fabrice Amiot's Great Grandmother. It is a blend of 3 plots and vinified 70% in tank and 30%. A wine full of tension, impressive power and subtlety. | |
| 37. Pinot Gris - Domain Road, Central Otago, New Zealand | 36.00 |
| Beautifully expressive and fragrant, the inviting bouquet shows white nectarine, poached pear and floral characters. The palate delivers excellent concentration and focus, beautifully enhanced by silky texture and rounded mouthfeel. | |
| 38. Meursault "Clos St Felix" 2017 - Domaine Michelot, Burgundy, France | 70.00 |
| Nutty, honeyed, rich and round with layer upon layer of pineapple, peach apple and pain grillé. A beautiful vibrancy gives life and energy. Powerful, hedonistic, yet utterly restrained, poised and focused | |

Wines that can be drunk easily without food at any time of the day and can be served lightly chilled on a hot summers day. Perfect with chicken, white meats, pasta and fuller flavoured fish dishes.

53. **Savigny les Beaune 'Vieilles Vignes' 2014** - Domaine Ecard, Burgundy 54.00
Lovely cherry and strawberry nuances, well rounded and a delicious finish. The wines of Michel Ecard have been a favourite of ours over the years so we were delighted to see he has now started his own domaine with his wife Joanna.
68. **Rioja Vega Venta Jalon Reserva 2014** - Rioja Spain 68.00
Rich and complex bouquet revealing terroir-driven balsamic and spicy varietal character. Full bodied, with a subtle underlying mineral character on the palate.
72. **Chateauneuf du Pape 2011** - Domaine Vieux Telegraphe, Rhone 76.00
“a sweet bouquet of spiced black cherries, plum, truffle, saddle leather and underbrush. Coming from tiny yields (which were down 50% from 2010), this medium to full-bodied 2011 is gorgeously textured and has solid mid-palate depth, terrific purity of fruit and ripe tannin. Relatively approachable and enjoyable even now, it should nevertheless evolve gracefully for 15-20 years.” Jeb Dunnuck
73. **Rioja Vega Gran Reserva 2015** - Rioja, Spain 48.00
Ruby red colour of medium intensity, clean and bright. Delicate and elegant balsamic aromas with well-integrated toasted hints. Soft and fine on the palate, with well balanced structure and a velvety texture.
